

In **CL**, we will be doing lots of talking about important events such as Bonfire night, Remembrance day, Diwali and Christmas. We will continue to sing rhymes such as 'Old MacDonald had a Farm', 'The Farmer's in his Den' and 'Higgy Piggy Hokey Cokey'.

In **Literacy**, we will learn about Guy Fawkes before reading 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will put our knowledge of Phonics into practice when labelling pictures to describe the wolf. We will even think about how we can trap a wolf! We will develop our list writing skills and use these to create our Christmas lists!

In **Maths**, we will be counting, comparing, subitising and demonstrating our understanding of numbers by making 5 in different ways. We will look at shapes and compare shapes with 1, 3 and 4 sides and create 2D pigs!

I'll Blow your House Down!



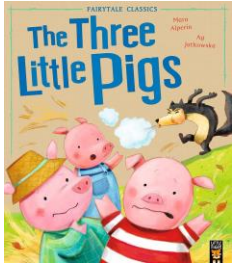

In **UW**, we will develop our understanding of historical figures and events when we learn about Guy Fawkes and Remembrance Day. We will look at materials and think about which materials would be good for building a house. We will investigate what happens to materials including bubbles when we blow. In RE, we will be learning about how different celebrations such as Diwali and Christmas are special.

In **EAD**, we will be using the musical instruments to create different sounds for fireworks. We will celebrate Diwali and Christmas through listening and moving to traditional music. We will develop our creative skills by blowing paint, making 3D houses and using threading to join materials. We will retell the story of 'The Three Little Pigs' in our role play.

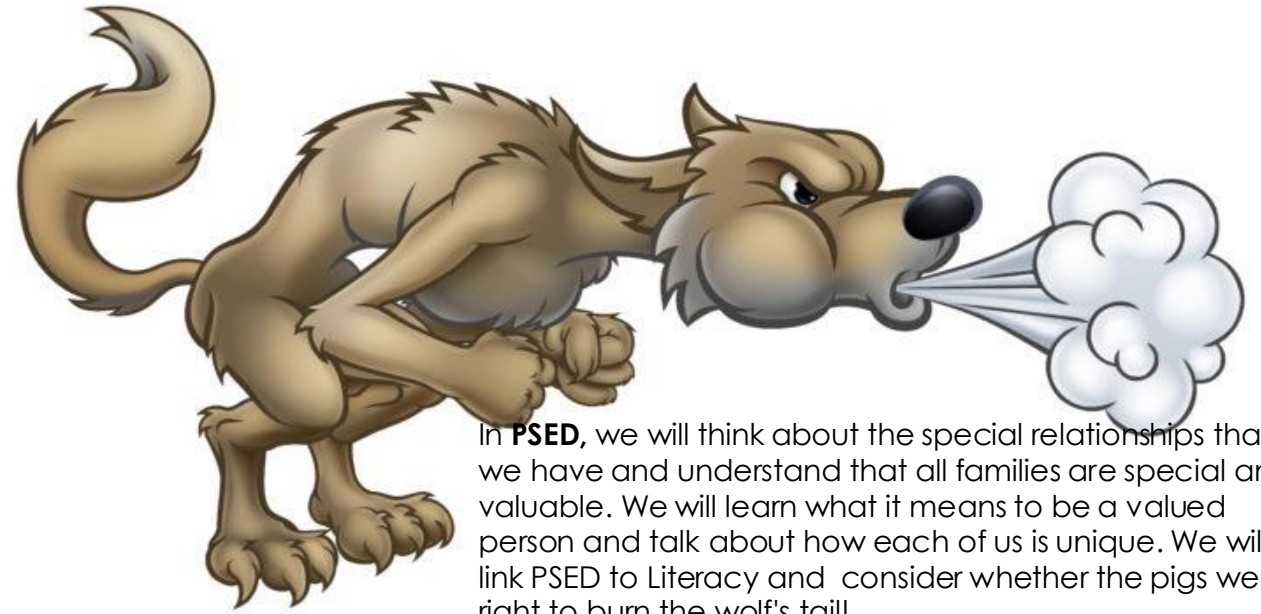
