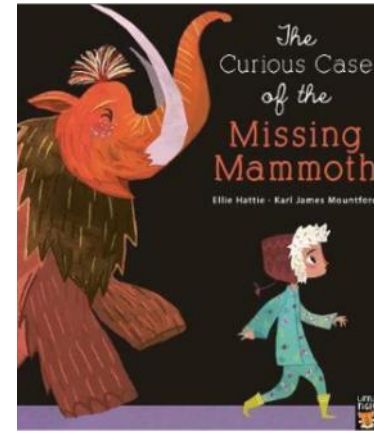


We are beginning to be scientists this week. We are going to explore objects and the materials they are made from.

Year 1 Spring Term



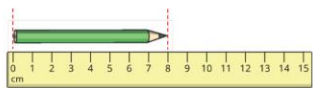
