Suggested apps:

	<b>ABC pocket phonics:</b> Phonics app that teaches Phase 2/3 GPC's, encourages blending of CVC words and letter formation.
	<b>Piano:</b> Listen to traditional and popular songs, follow the bubbles to play a well-known tune or compose your own melody.
	<b>Dora's great big world:</b> A selection of games focusing on literacy and maths skills. Help Dora complete the puzzles to earn badaes.
	<b>Shapes:</b> Learn shapes and more with fun aames. quizzes. flashcards and puzzles. With over 30 categories including: shapes, numbers, letters, animals and colours
	<b>Numberline frog:</b> An interactive number line. Generates number problems for addition and subtraction.
	<b>Little digits:</b> Little Digits displays number characters by detecting how many fingers you put down. Simple addition and subtraction problems.
	<b>Hairy Letters:</b> Learn the names and sounds of each letter with the Hairies. Learn to form each letter shape with your finger and play games to blend letter sounds into first words.
