SUPERHEROES

In Literacy, we will explore the exciting stories of the superhero 'SUPERTATO' who overcomes the Evil Peas! We will describe the characters, write speech bubbles and retell the story by writing a narrative.

In Maths, we will secure our knowledge of number through NCETM Maths. We will develop our understanding of numbers to 10 by subitising, comparing numbers, making number bonds, recalling number facts and counting beyond 20!

In PD, we will practice the skills needed for team games. We will use space to travel, balance and develop ball skills. We will even create a superhero assault course outside!

In PSED, we will look at how we manage ourselves by thinking about wellbeing. We will learn that healthy eating, exercise and relaxation are important. We will learn relaxation techniques and even try yoga!

In Art, we will create vegetable superheroes, use vegetables to print, create vegetable art inspired by Guiseppe Arcimboldo and design and make Evil Pea traps. In Music, we will learn about the instruments needed to create an orchestra and perform using instruments to others. We will also learn about Summer and create lots of summer related art pieces.

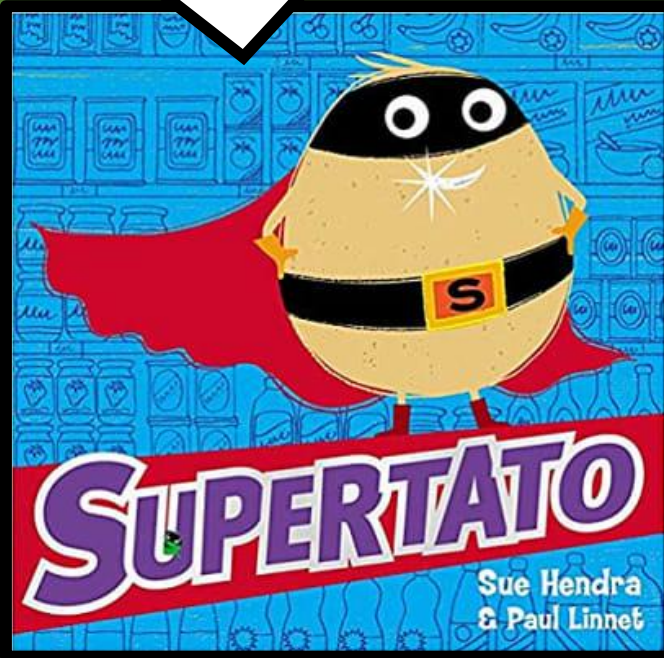

Look at some of the words that we will use!

In UtW, we will focus on finding out where vegetables come from and how they grow. We will investigate what happens to vegetables when they are left out, observe the changes in a boiled potato and look at life cycles. We will use our garden area to draw maps, grow herbs and sunflowers, investigate small insects and their habitats and measure rainfall.

In RE, we will look at stories from the Bible and think about what we can learn from them.



In C&L, we will use rhyme to explore poetry and learn new songs all about fruit and vegetables! We will talk about real life superheroes and the jobs our families do.
