In **Number**, we will consider the composition of 10. We will use the language more than and less than when describing numbers on a number track.


In **PSED**, we will develop team-work and problem-solving skills when we carry out our special 'Animal Rescue' missions.

We will be looking at the book 'The Selfish Crocodile' to discuss the feelings and behaviour of ourselves and others.






