
Ahov There!

> In Maths, we will focus on measure. We will explore capacity, mass, length and height and time. We will read scales with different increments and clocks. We will use this knowledge to solve problems involving measure. Using Beebots, we will use positional and directional language to find buried treasure!

We will consider people who care for us in **PSHE.** We will identify the characteristics of healthy family life, and how families provide protection and care in times of difficulty. We will recognise the importance of spending time together and of sharing each other's lives.
