Communicating with School Reminder

We have several ways that parents can communicate messages/information to school:

- Speak to staff outside during 'meet & greet'
- Speak to your child's class teacher before or after school
- Come into school to speak to the Admin staff (please be respectful of our rule of only one person in the foyer at a time to ensure privacy of conversations being had with parents)
- Call us on 01733 566849 this is best for absence notification preferably before 9.00am on the first day of absence please. There is an answer machine for out of school hours.

- We are aware that during the lockdown periods some parents may have been contacted by staff on their personal school emails. **Can we respectfully ask that you ensure that these email addresses are now deleted and you only use the office email address.** The office account is checked regularly throughout the day and using the office email address ensures your email gets to the correct person.
- School Website messages can be sent via the contact page on our school website, however, please do not use this for urgent messages as messages take longer to come through via this platform.
- Class Dojos this is our online platform for sharing information about the children's learning and how you can support them at home. If you connect your email to Dojos you can then communicate directly with the class teacher to ask any questions you may have regarding their learning. However, please <u>DO NOT</u> use this messaging system for any messages regarding attendance, or other urgent matters, as Dojos may not be checked during the school day.

The school is happy to support with the completion of forms or letters for families i.e. passport applications, on roll confirmations, benefit applications etc, however we do need you to give us **at least a week's notice please.**

Code of Conduct for online parents' evenings

Please ensure:

- All those attending the meeting are appropriately dressed for the meeting (i.e. wearing clothes, not pyjamas!).
- You are in a quiet space in your house (no TVs or radios on in the background).
- You check you are happy with what the teacher will be able to see as your background. If necessary, you can use the 'blurred background' option.
- Any mobile devices not being used for the meeting are switched off/on silent.
- No one attending the meeting is smoking or drinking alcohol. We appreciate the meeting is in your own home, but we would expect it to be treated in the same way as a face-to-face meeting in school.
- You are aware when your time is nearly up as the meeting will just end, even if you are mid-sentence!
- The children are occupied so we can have a 10 minute focused discussion with you.

Please note that the teacher reserves the right to end the meeting early if the behaviour/conduct of those attending is inappropriate.
