PE Reminder - EARRINGS.

The Association of Physical Education (2020), strongly recommends that the removal of personal items before every PE lesson (this includes our sports clubs). This is to ensure children are able to actively participate without endangering themselves or those around them. This applies to all earrings including retainer earrings.

Therefore, if your child has their ears pierced, please ensure that they are taken out on the days that the class has PE. This will enable your child to be fully active in our PE Curriculum and to develop the key skills taught by teaching staff and sports coaches safely.
